Identify sentence elements in the following sentence:

They make him the chairman every year.

A: They (S) make (V) him (O) the chairman (C) every year (A).

Categories of transitive verbs) انواع

- 1. **Mono-transitive**: it takes one object Ex: He wrote a letter She saw a Lion
- 2. **Di-transitive**: it takes two objects (direct and indirect) Ex: He gave her a book.
- 3. **Complex transitive**: it takes an object complement Ex: They made him the chairman The president declared the meeting open.

Compliments can be:

Subjective: The girl is a student at a large university

Or Objective: They made him the chairman.
